

Topic:

The EU Directive Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) became effective throughout Europe on the 13th of August 2005. The deadlines for the practical implementation, however, vary between the concerned European countries.

In Germany, for instance, where the EU Directive has been passed into national law with the „ElektroG“, the obligation of producers and importers to pick up the end-of-life devices collected by the town council and to recycle them does not begin before the 24th of March 2006. However, the effected companies must have registered at the National Clearing House already before the 24th of November 2005.

Aside from the requirements for the registration, this heterogeneity is also found in the registration process, logistics and recycling. This complicates the implementation of the WEEE Directive for the producers.

The producers have the obligation to allocate tasks. They themselves are responsible for meeting the lawful national requirements of the respective countries and for ensuring an appropriate implementation. The consequences of not meeting the deadlines are severe: The producers are no longer allowed to put electrical and electronic devices on the market.

The WEEE implementation panel offered corporately from TechProtect GmbH and RENE AG addresses the heterogeneity of the national implementations of the WEEE Directive. By "exploiting practical knowledge", the producers are presented the different requirements as well as suitable and already existent solutions.
